

Providing representations about ECGD's proposed arrangements for handling information about agent's identities

ECGD is to offer those Applicants who choose to take advantage of them special arrangements for handling information about agents' identities. The system that ECGD proposes for this purpose is appended at Annex C.

Representations on the terms of this system, but only on those terms, are invited from any consultee initially consulted or anyone who has responded to the Original Document or Interim Response in order to finalise this Consultation. Representations may be made in writing or orally or both. Written representations should be received by 7 April 2006.

When responding, please state whether you are responding as an individual or representing the views of an organisation. If responding on behalf of an organisation, please make it clear who the organisation represents and, where applicable, how the views of members were assembled.

According to the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act (2000), all information contained in your response, including personal information, may be subject to publication or disclosure. Moreover ECGD intends to publish all representations it receives unless: (a) confidentiality is requested and (b) it would be consistent with the Freedom of Information obligations not to disclose such representations.
